

Guidelines for Authors of *Contemporary Problems of Ecology*

Contemporary Problems of Ecology is a research journal focused on the basic aspects of modern ecology in the classical understanding of this term, that is, the science studying the entire set of complex relationships of living organisms with the environment. The journal does not accept papers on agriculture, medicine, veterinary, and technological processes or containing summary tables of taxon descriptions or other sizeable tabulated data.

The editorial board asks authors to prepare manuscripts according to the guidelines below. Manuscripts that do not comply with these guidelines will not be considered for publication. Submission and peer review processes are described below.

First step: Submission of a manuscript to the journal.

The manuscript is submitted only in digital form by e-mail: sibeco2012@mail.ru. Together with the manuscript, the authors should submit a cover letter and a [copyright transfer agreement](#) signed by all the authors. All file names should include the surname of the first author.

- The complete manuscript (with tables and figures) in PDF format with continuous line numbering.

- A cover letter and copyright transfer agreement. Each document should be in a separate file (Ivanov_napravlenie.pdf; Ivanov_lis.agreem.pdf).

Second step: Submission of the revised manuscript after review.

- The complete manuscript (with tables and figures) in a PDF file and a note of correction (Ivanov_ispravl.pdf);

- A letter from the authors containing responses to all reviewer comments and explanations of all changes made in the manuscript should be submitted with the revised version. (Ivanov_otvet.doc).

Third step: Acceptance of the manuscript for publication.

When the manuscript is approved by the editorial board, the following files should be submitted:

- Text in Microsoft Word format (with tables and captions at the end of the text): Ivanov_text.doc;

- Figures in separate files in required formats: Vector graphics in CorelDRAW programs (*.cdr, *.cmx, *.wmf), Microsoft Excel; photographs in Adobe Photoshop (*.tif, *.bmp, *.pcx); resolution, at least 400 dpi; file names: Ivanov_fig1, Ivanov_fig2;

- The complete manuscript (with figures) in PDF format (Ivanov.pdf);

- Information about authors, including family name, first and middle names, affiliations, phone numbers and e-mail addresses in a separate file.

The manuscripts should be prepared in Microsoft Word (*.doc, *.rtf). The text should be typeset with 1.5 spacing and 14-point Times New Roman font. Margins should be: left, 25 mm; top, 20 mm; right, 10 mm, bottom, 25 mm. The manuscript (including figures, references, and tables) should not exceed 25 pages (review and problematic articles, 35 pages).

The International System of Units (SI) should be used in the manuscript. All abbreviations mentioned in the text should be expanded on first mention.

Authors should follow the codes of biological nomenclature. When mentioned for the first time, all species and intraspecific taxa should be named in Latin (mandatory) indicating their authors.

The text of the manuscript should be arranged as follows:

1. Paper title.
2. Initials and surnames of authors.
3. Affiliations, postal addresses, and e-mail addresses.
4. Abstract (not more than ten lines).
5. Keywords (five to seven).
6. The text should be divided into sections: Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results, Discussion, Conclusions.
7. Acknowledgments
8. Author Contribution
9. Funding

10. Declarations (Ethics):

- Ethics approval and consent to participate
- Competing interests/Conflict of Interest

11. References.

References in the text should be given in square brackets: e.g., [1], [7–12]. References to unpublished works are not allowed. The formats of references in the list are as follows:

Do not submit legends to a figure; instead use numerical or letter symbols that are explained in the caption. Axes on the plots should be accompanied by titles explaining their meaning. The size of letters and numbers in figures should be proportional to the size of figures, so that they could remain readable upon reduction. Figure captions are listed on a separate page at the end of the paper.

Figures should be black-and-white. Publishing of color figures is permitted at the authors' expense.

Peer review is anonymous. Copies of reviewer comments are sent to the authors; originals are kept by the editorial board. If reviewers indicate that the manuscript needs revision, it is returned to the authors. The date of resubmission of the revised version is considered the date received.

The manuscript sent to the author for revision should be returned together with the initial version as soon as possible. A paper not returned by the authors for more than three months is considered new. The final decision on publication is made by the editorial board.

The editors reserve the right to edit the manuscript without distortion of meaning. The final text is agreed upon when proofs are sent to the authors for approval.
